### Judith Adelman Schwab, Artist/curator/Facilitator



Through the employment of the visual and creative arts, Judith has focused her attention on Women's rights, the value of positivity and the saving of our natural environment. She holds an M.F.A. in Sculpture from the University of Delaware 1986, a B.A. from Kean College of N.J. 1975 in fine Arts with a specialty in Creative Arts Education. Her sculptural installations and works on paper have been shown nationally at Museums, Universities, and internationally in Eastern Europe and Asia. Her work is represented by the **Artemis Gallery in Richmond Virginia**. She is a published author in puppetry approaches to Art education for exceptional students: see **Puppetry Language and the Special Child (a multi-media approach to language)**.

Ms. Schwab was awarded an **Established Artist Fellowship** in 1995 and in 1987 the **Emerging Artist Fellowship**, by the Delaware Division of the Arts through the **National Endowment for the Arts**. This noted practitioner has been granted numerous individual artist awards. She was recognized in 2008 with an **Individual Artist Grant** by the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, as recommended by the Broward Cultural Council. This Award was for "**Women Collared for Work**", an exhibition she curated that traveled the east coast Museum circuit for three years, opening in 2009 at the **Coral Springs Museum of Art**. In 2015 she curated, Marilyn Biles, mixed media oils on canvas, "Ideas in Color", for the **Jung Center Houston, Texas**.
